DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Monday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: air sound (air is a trigraph- 3 letters that make one sound) (Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow/oi sounds) Watch "Geraldine the giraffe learns air" (see link below) Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a book from home.</p> <p>Maths: Have a go at doing our Outdoor maths trail challenge! Look at the cards and see how many objects you need to find. You can make shapes too!</p> <p>Literacy: Listen to the story of The Three Little Pigs (see link below). Can you remember what the wolf said to the three little pigs?</p> <p>Science: Three Little pigs House Building Challenge. Can you challenge yourselves to make some houses from different materials. Which is the strongest? Use a squeeze bottle to find out! (see Science sheets)</p>
Tuesday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: air sound (Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow/oi sounds) Look at the wizards as they learn the air sound! (See BBC Bitesize link below) Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a book from home.</p> <p>Maths: Maths challenge! Challenge yourself with exploring patterns, take away, doubling and counting to 20. (see sheets)</p> <p>Literacy: Can you sequence the pictures of The Three Little Pigs? (see sheet). Challenge: Write a sentence under each picture. You can use the word mat to help you.</p> <p>Topic/Creative: Make some finger puppets of The Three Little Pigs? Tell the story using the puppets. (see sheet)</p> <p>Science: Make some Muddy Little Pig biscuits!</p>
Wednesday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: air sound (Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow/oi sounds) Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a book from home.</p>

Maths: Maths challenge! Challenge yourself with exploring patterns, take away, doubling and counting to 20. (see sheets)

Literacy: Read the ebook of The Three Little Pigs. Can you act out the story of The Three Little Pigs? You may need some of your family to take part!

Topic/ Creative: Draw or paint a picture of the Three Little Pigs (See the youtube clip below- Art for Kids).
