Topic: Under the sea

DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Monday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: oi sound (as in oin)</p> <p>(Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow sounds)</p> <p>Watch "Geraldine the giraffe learns oi" (see link below)</p> <p>Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards!</p> <p>Read a book from Bug Club or a book from home.</p> <p>Maths: Under the sea addition. Count the sea creatures carefully and use the number line to help you with correct number formation.</p> <p>Literacy: Listen to the story of Rainbow Fish by Marcus Pfister (see link below). Discuss these questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• How does the Rainbow Fish feel about his beautiful scales?• Why do you think the little blue fish wants one of Rainbow Fish's special scales?• How do you think the other fish felt when Rainbow Fish wouldn't play with them?• How did the other fish feel when Rainbow Fish shared his with them?• What could we share with our friends? <p>Science: Use the clues to help you guess the sea creatures on the Who am I? PPT</p>
Tuesday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: oi sound (as in oin)</p> <p>(Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow sounds)</p> <p>Colour in the real and nonsense words with an oi sound.</p> <p>Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards!</p> <p>Read a book from Bug Club or a book from home.</p> <p>Maths: Under the sea subtraction. Use the number line to help you count back carefully.</p> <p>Literacy: Write some sentences about the Rainbow fish using the prompt sheet.</p> <p>Topic/Creative: Make a beautiful Rainbow fish using different coloured paint or crayons and sparkly glitter too! (see image below)</p> <p>Song: Under the Sea (from The Little Mermaid - Disney). Sing along, the words are on the screen to help you!</p>

Wednesday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: oi sound (as in oin) (Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow sounds) Watch "Alphablocks - recapping the oi sound (see link below) Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a book from home. Maths: Colour and count the sea creatures on the sheet. Literacy: Write a book review of the Rainbow Fish. Did you enjoy it? What was your favourite part of the story? (see book review sheet) Read the sentences and colour in the sea creatures (see sheet). Topic/ Creative: Draw a step by step picture of a seahorse and a starfish! (see youtube clips below)</p>
Thursday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: oi sound (as in oin) (Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow sounds) Use the phoneme spotter sheet and colour in all the oi words. Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards! Maths: Topmarks: Have fun playing the Underwater counting game! (see link below) Literacy: Write some sentences about the sea creatures. You can use the word mat to help you. Try to remember finger spaces, full stops and capital letters. (see sheets). Science: Can you guess which objects float or sink? Have a guess before you experiment. Use the sheet to help you. Topic/Creative: Make an underwater collage using felt or coloured paper (see sheets) Song: Sing- Five Little Fishes (see song sheet)</p>
Friday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: oi sound (as in oin) (Phase 3 review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar/or/ ur/ ow sounds) Practise the Teddy Bear word and sound cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a book from home. Maths: Have fun playing the Dice Addition game with your family. Roll 2 dice, add the numbers together and put your counter on the number. The winner gets 4 in a row! Literacy: Join in with singing the Phase 4 tricky words song! (see link below). Practise reading these tricky words by sight: have said like come some what when Science: Have fun with the floating egg experiment (see sheet). What did you find out? Topic/Creative: Make a mermaid/merman using a handprint (see sheets) or have a go at some soap bubble prints! Story: Listen to Tiddler by Julia Donaldson (see link below).</p>
