No jewellery should be worn at school. Earrings should be small studs, and these should be removed for PE. If you are unsure of your class PE days, they please speak to your class teacher.

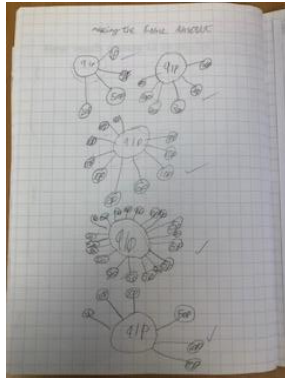
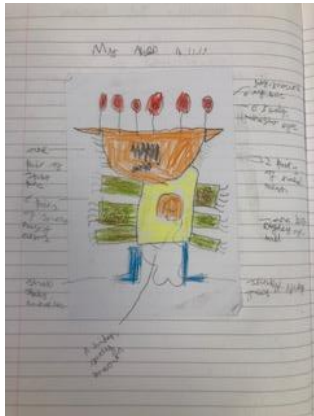
Long hair needs to be tied back and out of the children's faces.

No nail polish please. Keep those lovely treats for weekends and holidays!

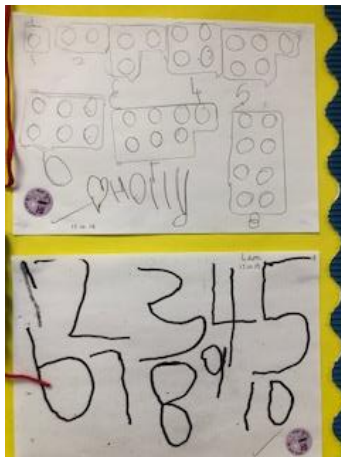
What's been happening in school?
