Look at the PowerPoint on Herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores. Write some sentences about each type, but try to make your sentences exciting by including adjectives and lots of facts and examples of different animals.

As an extension- Maybe you could write a short story too?!

When writing please ensure you are remember to use;

- Capital letters (at the beginning of sentences, for names/places)
- Full stops (at the end of sentences)
- Finger spaces after every word (no letter!)
- Neat handwriting (we are nearly Year 2 so need to keep improving our writing)
- Writing on the line!!
- Careful of letter size (tall letters are tall, small letters are small, and hanging letters hang under the line).
- Adjectives (make your writing exciting by using at least 1 adjective in a sentence if you can)
- Similes also take writing to the next level so try and use some of these

The children have been taught all of the above so please try to remind them of how to use them and encourage them to use them in their writing.

Green chilli- write 3 or 4 sentences

Orange chilli- write 5 or 6 sentences

Red chilli- write 7 or more sentences.
