Topic: On the Farm!

Here is the timetable for this week's learning. The topic this week is On the Farm! Have fun learning about farm animals and what the baby animals are called. Enjoy a virtual tour round Bocketts farm and learn about the animals that live there. Listen to the story of Farmer Duck and how hard poor duck has to work! Remember that these activities are suggestions and the learning needs to fit in with you as a family. It would be lovely if you could continue to read stories together and have some fresh air and exercise! Keep safe and well!

DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Monday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: or sound (review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar sounds) Watch "Geraldine the giraffe learns or." (see link below) Read and roll game (words with or sound). Roll a dice and then read and colour the word which matches the number on the dice. (see sheet) Practise reading the Teddy Bear word cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a story you have at home Maths: Halving and sharing: Continuing our maths theme from last week, can the children remember what a half is? Find a handful of objects (stones, small toys etc). Find 2 soft toys and then the children can share out the small objects so that each soft toy has half. Cut an apple/orange in half so that your child can see what a half is. Literacy: Listen to the story of Farmer Duck by Martin Waddell (see link below). Sequence the story pictures and, if you wish to, write a sentence underneath each picture. You can use the word mat to help you. (see sheets) Science: Introduce yourself to this week's topic by navigating the Bocketts Farm website (see link below). We were due to visit here for our first school trip, but we would love you to look together at all the farm animals they have living there. Which is your favourite animal? Art/Topic: Have fun making a farm animal handprint (see example below)</p>
Tuesday	<p>Phonics/ Reading: or sound (review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ ar sounds) Cut and stick the letters to make some words with the or sound (see sheet) Practise reading the Teddy Bear word cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a story you have at home Maths: Halving fruit for parrots PPT. Have a go at sharing out the fruit between the parrots (see link below) Literacy: Write a postcard to Duck from the Farmer. You can draw a picture for the front of the postcard and write a message to duck - is the farmer sorry because he was lazy and made duck do all the work? (see postcard template) Science: Can you match the mother animal to its young? (see worksheet)</p>

	<p>Art: Can you draw or paint a picture of your favourite farm animal from the Farmer Duck story?</p>
Wednesday	<p>Phonics/Reading: Watch "Alphablocks - recapping the or sound (link below) (review ai/ ee /oa/ long oo/ar sounds) Practise reading the Teddy Bear word and sound cards! Read a book from Bug Club or a story you have at home Maths: Halving the bees activity (see sheet). Use objects to help you if needed. Literacy: Listen to "Old MacDonald had a Farm" nursery rhyme. Sing along! Write down your own version of the rhyme, adding in new animals of your choice. (see link to song below) Topic/ Science - Look at the Powerpoint: "All about farm animals" - see link below. Can you answer the questions at the end of the PPT? Can you name all the baby animals?</p>
Thursday	<p>Phonics/Reading: Starfall - My Horse Glory Have fun finding the or words in the picture. (see link below) Read a book from Bug Club or a story you have at home. Practise reading the Teddy Bear word cards! Maths: Helicopter Rescue Game (find the number from 1-10/1-20 -start off with an easier number and see how far you can get). See link below. Literacy: What can you see in the farmyard picture? (see sheet). Write some sentences on the farmyard writing frame using the farm word mat to help you. (see sheets) Topic/Creative: Use toy tractors or cars to create an amazing Tyre Track Painting (see picture below).</p>
Friday	<p>Phonics/Reading: Play Phonicsplay (online): Picnic on Pluto - Phase 3. Sound out and blend the words and sort them into real/alien words. (see website link below) Use your Teddy Bear sound cards to practise all your phonics! Read a book from Bug Club or a story you have at home Practise reading the Teddy Bear word cards! Maths: Write each number to 20 on separate pieces of paper, mix them up and order them to 20. Ask an adult to turn a number over, can you work out which number is missing? Which number is before/after that number? Order the teen numbers on the Oxford Owl website. (see link). Literacy: Read and write the following silly sentences. Identify examples of digraphs (e.g. ck, qu, sh, ee, oa, oo, ai, ar). Ask your child to answer yes or no to the following questions: Can a duck quack? Can a sheep swim in the pond? Will a goat be good at sailing a boat? -Might I see a pig in the mud on a farm?</p>


