- Reading books will be changed every day **if** your child has read (please place in box outside)
- Please sign and make a positive comment every time your child reads in Reading Record book
- Guided reading in a group once a week (focus on reading comprehension)

- Independence – putting letters in own book bags, changing, initiating their own learning Resourcefulness
- Collaboration!
- Perseverance
- Managing distractions
- Noticing skills
- Be absorbed in their learning
